## Superintendent's Report

Dr. Chris Kennedy, Superintendent, welcomed everyone and began the specially called meeting bringing these items for board consideration:

- Dr. Kennedy presented the district's long-term substitute teacher compensation plan and requested approval from the board.
  - Motion to approve the compensation plan was made by Reneé Dow
  - Second to the motion was offered by Nancy Staton
  - Board approved the compensation plan 4-0 as Kimberly Oliver abstained from participating in the vote.
- Dr. Kennedy shared a compensation adjustment for board members
  which would bring in line TCS board member compensation with the other
  two boards of education in Davidson County. Dr. Kennedy recommended
  the board approve the adjustment for compensation and indicated that if
  the board approved the pay would be retroactive to the beginning of the
  2022-2023 school year.

- Motion was seconded by Nancy Staton
- Motion carried 5-0 and will be retroactive to the beginning of 2022-2023 as proposed.
- Dr. Kennedy revisited his entry and first year plan with the board. Dr.
  Kennedy indicated that the work outlined within the plan is complete but
  noted that some items will be on-going into the foreseeable future for the
  betterment of district outcomes.
