Subject: Continuing Spending Resolution

A continuing spending resolution is required to permit the expenditure of any funds by the Board of Education beginning July 1, 2022. This is a proactive request to authorize expenditures at the same level approved for the 2021-2022 school year. Based on the current state political situation, our major 2022-2023 funding allocations are unlikely by June 30, 2022. Recommending a resolution at this spending level allows the administration to continue spending for salaries, benefits, and other required expenditures to operate the school system while waiting on final state allocations, updated state salary schedules, required employer benefit increases, federal planning budgets, and other final funding allocations. This resolution would only authorize any salary changes to 2022-2023 employees once a State Budget becomes law.

RESOLUTION:

Be it, therefore, resolved that the Thomasville City Board of Education authorizes an appropriation of funds at the same funding level as 2021-2022 for the purpose of paying current salaries, employer-paid benefits, and ordinary expenditures for the period of time until the State of NC passes a bi-annual budget.
