Thomasville City Schools 2022-2025 AIG Plan Summary

Thomasville City Schools has developed this local AIG plan based on the NC AIG Program Standards (adopted by SBE 2009, 2012, 2015, 2018, and 2021). These Standards serve as a statewide framework and guide Local Education Agencies to develop, coordinate and implement thoughtful and comprehensive AIG programs.

The NC AIG Program Standards encompass six principle standards with accompanying practices. These standards articulate the expectations for quality, comprehensive, and effective local AIG programs and relate to the categories related to North Carolina's AIG legislation. Article 9B (N.C.G.S 115C-150.5). These best practices help clarify the standard, describe what an LEA should have in place, and guide Local Education Agencies to improve their programs.

As Local Education Agencies continue to transform their AIG Programs and align to the AIG Program Standards, Local Education Agencies participated in self-assessment processes of their local AIG program, which involved multiple stakeholders. The data gathered during this process guided Local Education Agencies in developing this local AIG plan for 2022-2025. School systems must submit a local plan to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction for approval every three years. Plans contain information about student identification, comprehensive programming, curriculum and instruction, professional development, partnerships, and program accountability. Thomasville City Schools has developed this local plan based on those six standards with accompanying practices. These standards articulate our program development, revision, and monitoring expectations. This local AIG plan has been approved by the Local Education Agencies Board of Education and sent to NCDPI for comment.
