## **ESSER III Update**

3rd round of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funding is ready for disbursement from DPI

- Same purposes as ESSER II, including:
  - Addressing learning loss
  - Summer programming
  - School facility upgrades for virus mitigation
- Minimum 20% must be reserved for learning loss
- Available through September 30, 2024

## **ESSER III In-Person Learning Plan**

Highlights of the plan:

- Returning to 5 days per week, effective August 16
- All instruction will be in-person
- Will continue to follow NC StrongSchools Toolkit and utilize risk mitigation strategies
- Will adhere to CDC, NCDHHS, and DCHD guidelines regarding contact tracing, quarantine, and isolation for students and staff who contract Covid or are presumptive positive.
