




1. Does your child find the classroom activities and experiences interesting?



2. Do you and your child talk about school activities and experiences at home?




3. Have you visited the Parent Library located at your child's school?






4. Overall, do teachers and administrative staff address your questions in a thorough and timely manner? (Remember the 24-hour rule.)






5. How often do you check the Parent Portal?




6. Do you feel welcome, valued, and in partnership with your child's school?






7. Has your child's teacher(s) worked with you to establish and maintain ongoing, two-way communication?






8. Do you feel your child's teachers have a positive attitude toward your child and family?






9. Are you satisfied with opportunities for family involvement (events, education opportunities, resources)?

- 1. Overall reputation of the school system, Attitude of some of the staff I've witnessed while visiting a school
- 2. Test scores, Overall score, Communication on field trips/awards ahead of time rather than 1 week or 2 days prior
- 3. School Score, Better EOG scores, More tutoring
- 4. Behavior problems in classrooms, Kids that are taking away from other children learning
- 5. The automated phone calls need a lot of improvement. Last year's automated calls were clear/easy to understand as well as the translation. This new system makes it very difficult to understand in both English and especially almost impossible to understand in Spanish.
- 6. I would like to see parent activity and resources take place directly in the neighborhoods to overcome the transportation challenge of this population.



- 7. More homework for children who are above their grade level, Meetings with parents only that would be interesting for parents...to socialize and learning different languages, Better grade for the school, What we as parents can do to help improve the school score
- 8. More involvement & encouragement with parents, More open communication between parent & teacher, College resources for students
- 9. Better communication with teachers when something going on with student...don't let the problem continue to happen...call parent right then

46. I wish the 3rd grade curriculum schedule was not designed to function at such a fast pace. I feel that I am having to teach my child outside of the classroom and invest in other services (tutoring) because the teacher is forced to follow a curriculum at such a fast pace. There is very little time to help the students who need more understanding of techniques (concepts) especially with math. As I attended the awards program for the first quarter at TPS, it was obvious that the number of students who made the A or A/B honor roll was much lesser than those who excelled in reading. Also, additional programs/activities should be considered to help the kids with critical thinking skills (STEM) to prepare them for standardized testing (EOGs). I am a graduate of TCS & attribute much of my success to the education I received from the TCS system. However, I feel that many of the kids are at a disadvantage due to a curriculum that is being enforced with very little resources and time in place to ensure that the kids are learning to their full potential & have the assistance available if needed.
