
"Science of Reading" (SoR) means evidence-based reading instruction practices that address the acquisition of language, phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics and spelling, fluency, vocabulary, oral language, and comprehension that can be differentiated to meet the needs of individual students.

Science of Reading LETRS Training 2022-2024

As part of the Read to Achieve Legislation, [North Carolina Department of Public Instruction](#) has contracted with Lexia Learning System to provide the LETRS (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) training to all Pre-k through 5th grade teachers and support staff as well as school admins. The teacher training will span two years but the pre-k and admin will only be one year. Below are the total hours of training, including independent reading, completing activities, and attending professional development. The face to face professional development will occur on teacher required workdays for the 2022-2023 school year.


