Safety and Security Measures in Thomasville City Schools

Current Physical Safety Measures

Each school in TCS plus Central Office and the Guilford Street Annex is access-controlled through a two-way admittance system into the building. Access systems are video and audio-enabled.

Current Physical Safety Measures

TCS has a video monitoring system that utilizes 177 cameras across the six sites

Current Safety Collaborations

TCS contracts with the City of Thomasville to provide school resource officers

 We receive about 20% of the cost for this from the state; the district is responsible for the rest TCS collaborates with Thomasville
Police Department, Thomasville Fire
Department, Davidson County
Emergency Management, and other
key responders in developing the
district safety and emergency
management plan

- Tabletop exercises held yearly to plan and improve safety response
- Required school drills throughout the year

Current District Safety Measures

- Visitor management systems
- Each school maintains a safety plan that is reviewed yearly by the district safety director
- The district safety team meets throughout the year to address safety needs
- Gaggle cyber-monitoring system provides alerts to school and district staff
 of threats and situations discovered through district online platforms
- All students in grades 6-12 have access to and receive training in the Say
 Something Anonymous Reporting System
- Collaborative trauma support teams with DCS and LCS

Future Safety Measures

Using the Department of Justice Safety Grant, over the next 12-18 months TCS will deploy:

- Professional safety and risk assessments
- Raptor Emergency Management System
 - Manage drills
 - Incident reporting (panic button)
 - Communication and notifications
 - Reunification
- Integrated district communication
- Improvements and upgrades to building access
