Proposal/Recommendations - Masks in TCS 2022

CURRENTLY:

Masks/Face coverings remain required for students, staff and visitors on all TCS transportation and in all TCS buildings and facilities through February 4, 2022.

RECOMMENDATION - February 1, 2022 BoE Meeting:

Masks/Face coverings remain required for students, staff and visitors on all TCS transportation and in all TCS buildings and facilities through March 4, 2022.

FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION AND DISCUSSION - February 24, 2022 BoE Briefing and March 1, 2022 BoE Monthly Meeting:

- Review school/district and Davidson County data at March BoE Briefing and BoE Regular Monthly Meeting. If School/district data remains below 5% and Davidson County data remains below 10%, move to optional masks/face coverings on March 7, 2022. If data is above 5% for school/district or 10% for Davidson County, based on review of data, requirements for masks/face coverings remain in place until the next Board of Education Meeting March 31 BoE Briefing and April 5 BoE Regular Monthly Meeting).
- 2. If the move is made to optional masks/face coverings, data will continue to be reviewed each Thursday. Should data go above 5% for schools/district or above 10% for Davidson County, the emergency authorization granted to the superintendent by the Board of Education will be used to return to a required masks/face coverings be reinstated for AT LEAST two full school weeks (10 full school days) or until school/district data returns below 5% and Davidson County data returns below 10%.
- 3. Visitors to TCS buildings and facilities (non-students, non-staff) will be required to wear masks/face coverings.
- 4. Spectators and/or audiences at indoor school events (athletics, music performance, etc.) will be required to wear masks/face coverings.
- 5. When CDC transmission data for Davidson County reaches "moderate" (yellow) or "low" (blue), all masks/face covering requirements will be discontinued and made optional while in that status.
- 6. All quarantine and isolation measures from NCDHHS remain in effect and guidelines and procedures in the NC Strong Schools Toolkit will continue to be followed until further notice.
