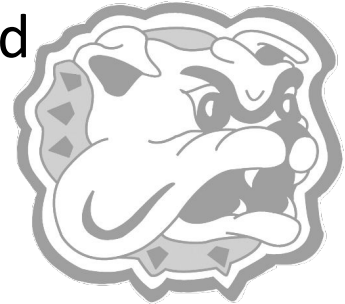
B.O.S.S. - Bulldogs Out for Summer Success





SL 2021-7 Requirements

- Session Law 2021-7 (also known as HB 82) establishes school extension learning recovery and enrichment programs in each public school unit to mitigate the impacts of Covid-19 on at-risk students.
- These summer programs must provide 150 hours of in-person instruction targeting at-risk students and including others on a space-available basis.





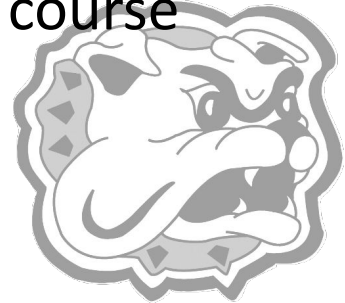
SL 2021-7 Provisions

Grades K-8

- K-2 - reading and math instruction
- 3-8 - reading, math, and science instruction
- Enrichment/physical activity

Grades 9-12

- In-person instruction in EOC courses
- In-person instruction in at least one elective course
- Credit recovery





SL 2021-7 Provisions

- All levels must offer time for small group/individual instruction
- All levels must offer social/emotional learning supports
- Grades 3-8 must administer a competency-based pre- and post-assessment
- Read to Achieve summer reading camp may be integrated into this program





SL 2021-7 Provisions

- Districts must provide transportation
- Districts must provide meals
- Teachers and other employees are on temporary contracts - do not accrue leave or retirement.
- Program is to be funded with Federal ESSER II funds and other existing fund sources





B.O.S.S. at TCS

- TCS has created a summer learning plan that is compliant with all the provisions of SL 2021-7.
- Each school has been given the opportunity to craft a program that fits the need of their school, students, and staff
- Each school is using data to prioritize students to invite and developing a recruitment plan
 - All students at risk of retention must be invited
 - Minimum of 10:1 student:teacher ratio





B.O.S.S. at TCS

Summer program will run for 6 weeks in two sessions:

- Session 1: June 14-July 1 (M-Th)
- Session 2: July 12-July 29 (M-Th)

Daily schedule includes 6.25 hours of instruction, not including lunch and physical activity

- TPS/LDES: 7:45-3:00
- TMS/THS: 8:15-3:30





B.O.S.S. Logistics

Staff recruitment/compensation

- 10-month employees paid hourly/daily rate +25%
- 11-month employees paid for 12th month
- Drivers paid \$15/hour
- Signing bonus of \$1,200 for National Boards or previous state growth bonus (per SL 2021-7)
- \$150 for each 3rd grader that becomes proficient in summer (per SL 2021-7)





B.O.S.S. Logistics

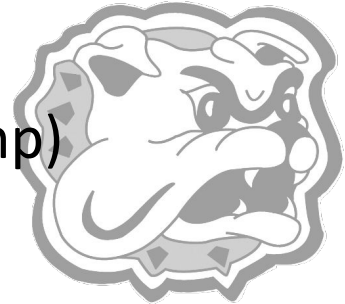
- Students will receive breakfast and lunch as part of summer feeding program
- Transportation will be provided in tiered runs

Anticipated budget:

\$593,635 - PRC 171 (ESSER II)

\$ 93,388 - PRC 016 (Read to Achieve summer camp)

\$687,023 - Total

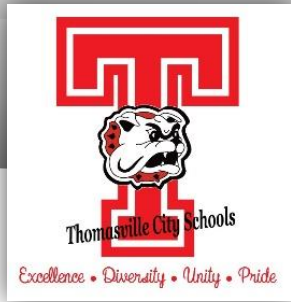




B.O.S.S. at Thomasville Primary

- TPS will offer reading, math, and science to grades K-3
- RtA summer reading camp will be integrated into the program
- TPS will offer PE and media as enrichment
- Second Steps SEL program will be offered





B.O.S.S. at Thomasville Primary

- TPS has identified 23 teachers/3 classified to work
 - EC/EL teachers included
- TPS is utilizing a 3-tiered process to identify students to invite for participation





B.O.S.S. at Liberty Drive

- LDES will offer reading, math, and science to grades 4-5
- LDES will offer a rotation of 10 enrichment clubs that are aligned to core academics; students will participate in 2 each day
- Second Steps SEL program will be offered, along with small-group team building and weekly school-wide meetings





B.O.S.S. at Liberty Drive

- LDES has identified 12 teachers/3 classified to work
 - EC/EL teachers included
 - Adaptive curriculum will be offered
- LDES is utilizing a 2-tiered prioritized list to identify students to invite for participation





B.O.S.S. at Thomasville Middle

- TMS will offer reading, math, and science to grades 6-8
- TMS will offer a rotation of Paxton-Patterson, STEM, and physical activity for enrichment
- SEL will be offered through morning and afternoon meetings, plus offerings in character ed, Pride Academy, and team building





B.O.S.S. at Thomasville Middle

- TMS has identified 19 teachers/3 classified to work
 - EC/EL teachers included
- TMS is utilizing a 3-tiered prioritized list to identify students to invite for participation as well as identifying students who attended Saturday Academy





B.O.S.S. at Thomasville High

- THS will offer:
 - In-person instruction in Biology, English II, Math 1, and Math 3
 - CTE courses for initial credit
 - Opportunities for missed credentialing
 - Credit recovery through the Edgenuity platform
 - ACT Prep
 - Summer Bridge for 9th-10th students





B.O.S.S. at Thomasville High

- THS has identified 11 teachers/3 classified to work
 - EC teachers included
- THS is prioritizing current seniors, current juniors off cohort track, and any student who needs to recover credit. Students who passed all courses may take an elective for initial credit





Next Steps

- Submission of plan for Board review - April 28
- Submission of plan for DPI review - by May 3
 - Revision from DPI as applicable
- Identification and recruitment of students - ongoing through June 4
- Submission of summer contracts to Board - May 26 for approval at June 1 meeting
