




2018-19 Thomasville City School Storyline

- Three of the schools met or exceeded growth
 - Thomasville Middle exceeded growth with a growth index of 2.87
 - TMS exceeded growth two years in a row
 - All of the subgroups at 3 schools Met or Exceeded Growth
- Graduation Rate increased 7%
- English II EOC 6% increase in Proficiency
- 5th Grade Science proficiency increased 13%
- 7th to 8th Grade Math proficiency increased 12%
- Over 95.6% of Graduating Seniors took a higher level








End of Course Proficiency






Thomasville City Schools Data Summary
